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Important notes:

How to access program activities?:

- Attendees will be able to access the Virtual Conference Center with the login information provided at the time of registration.
- Attendees will access sessions through the doors of the Conference Rooms and/or Activities Room in the Virtual Conference Center posted in the program.

ISCA 2021 Speaker (or Panelist) and Session Chair (or Panel Moderator) Guidelines

Note: For panels, please regard “Speaker” as “Panelist” and “Session Chair” as moderator below, as applicable.

We will be using Zoom in webinar mode. For speakers and session chairs, live sessions will look a lot like a regular Zoom meeting. One major difference will be that the audience won't have audio and video capability; instead, they will be able to ask questions using a Q&A box. The content of this Q&A box will be available to session chairs.

Setup

- **Every session chair and speaker will receive a unique URL to their session. Do not share this URL with anyone, and do not try to log into your session through the virtual conference venue.** Please make sure you have received the link at least one day before your session.



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- **Think ahead of time where you may want to connect from.** Please use the most reliable, highest bandwidth connection available to you. This may mean a different location/computer from where you otherwise enjoy the conference as a regular attendee.
- **IMPORTANT: Speakers and session chairs should log into their session thirty minutes before that session's start time in the conference program.**
- **Speakers** should send their session chair a short intro/bio and a backup copy of their slides ahead of time.

Technical Paper Sessions

- **Speakers will not choose questions; session chairs will.** There will be two sources: One, the offline comments by attendees in the comments box for each paper in the program. Two, the Q&A box during the live session.
- **Authors** may answer questions posed in the comments box in the program using that same interface at any time. However, we would discourage providing extensive answers to questions asked prior to the live session, and instead save that question for the session chair. Note that one can always go back and answer it more fully afterwards.
- **Session chairs** should go through the offline comments for each paper prior to the session and take notes, as this will help them identify questions the audience may have about the work. They should feel free to bring up at the live session questions that authors may have already answered offline, so that the speaker may answer them (again) for the benefit of all attendees. Session chairs should also prepare a few questions of their own.
- **Session chairs** will read out loud each chosen question, for the benefit of the speaker and the entire audience.
- **Speakers and session chairs** should abide by the time allotted to each paper, without jumping to the next paper too early or too late.
